

**2009 Kevin Donley Football Camps
Release of Liability/Medical Consent Form**

The undersigned do hereby give permission for _____, a minor child, (herein the "individual") to attend and participate in the 2009 Kevin Donley Football Camps.

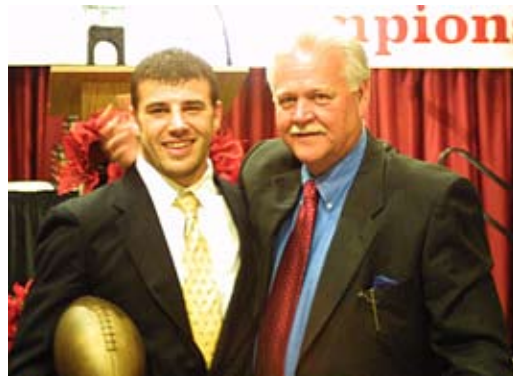

USF head coach **Kevin Donley** is the 'Founding Father' of collegiate football in Fort Wayne and his guidance has led the Cougars to a 112-15 record over the last 10 seasons, an .882 winning percentage, eight-consecutive Mid-States Football Association Midwest League titles, nine in the last 10 seasons, and 10-consecutive berths in the NAIA Championship Series including three straight

runner-up finishes. USF won a school record 13-straight games in 2004, 2005 and 2006 and advanced to the NAIA Championship Series National Championship all three seasons. Donley, who was inducted into the Georgetown College (Ky.) Hall of Fame in the spring of 2004, and the Indiana Football Hall of Fame in 2005, developed the USF football program from scratch starting in April 1997 and the Cougars have been a perennial NAIA Top 25 team ever since. After the 2005 season, Donley was named Schutt Coach-of-the Year in the NAIA.

Donley-coached teams have won 16 conference titles and he ranks second in the nation (NAIA) in wins among active coaches with 229. He has had head coaching stints at Anderson College (Ind.), Georgetown College (Ky.) and California University (Pa.) in addition to his time in Fort Wayne at USF. He directed Georgetown to the 1991 NAIA II National Championship and was named NAIA National Coach of the Year for the first time.
