Carter darted through a hole in the Saint Xavier University defense and beyond for a 63-yard touchdown that vaulted the USF Cougars out of a tie at 24 into a 47-30 win to lock up its ninth Mid-States Football Association Mideast League championship and its sixth unbeaten regular season in the last seven. Carter darted, dodged, and dashed into the USF record book with a 239-yard rushing effort, scored three touchdowns and locked up the 2008 MSFA scoring title.

Sam Miles led a swarming USF defense with two interceptions for 67 yards. Paul Carter III snared his 21st career INT and Donavon Evans snared another giving USF four. Mark Drobac and Tim Farrell forced fumbles, Farrell had the Cougars only sack and Joe Piowoszkin had a fumble recovery.

"Our line did an outstanding job to get me running room," Carter said. "What a great sight to see that hole open so wide. Just great blocking."

Miles second interception of the game gave USF great field position at the SXU 15, but the Cougars stopped Bo Frye at their 6-yard line on fourth and one. USF forced a 3-and out, which turned into a fourth and out, as in the snap from center on a fourth down punt attempt out of the SXU end zone sailed out of the end zone for a USF safety and a 33-24 lead.

With the wind at their back, USF regained possession at the USF 41 and Bo Frye pushed USF's lead to 40-24 with 3:17 to play. Bart Schnur, playing with one good hand, made an incredible one-handed TD catch in the third quarter for a 24-16 USF lead after SXU had drawn to within a point.

NAIA Top 25 NOTES: The University of Saint Francis boasts the longest consecutive stretch of being named in the Coaches' Top 25 Poll – now standing at 125 straight mentions – the last time USF was not mentioned in the Top 25 was Oct. 19, 1999... Talk about consistency, the top three teams in the poll have been ranked the same each week... No. 2 Carroll (Mont.) has been either No. 1 or No. 2 for the last 30 straight rankings... Sioux Falls (S.D.) has now been ranked No. 1 a total of 40 times since the 2000 season including 23 mentions since 2007... The No. 1 Sioux Falls defense has been getting the job done as no opposing player has rushed for 100 yards or more since the 2007 National Championship – a span of 23 games... Seven teams in the country boast undefeated records with Carroll (Mont.) and St. Xavier (Ill.) holding the most wins (10)... The last time a team other than Carroll (Mont.) and Sioux Falls (S.D.) was ranked at No. 1 was Saint Francis (Ind.) on Nov. 12, 2006 – a streak of 38 polls... Carroll has now been ranked in the Top 5 in the last 61 straight polls dating back to November, 2004... After St. Francis, Carroll is the next team in line with 112 straight Top 25 rankings while Sioux Falls stands at 111 straight mentions... Since 2000, Carroll has been ranked No. 1 53 times, the highest amount of any program during that time span; Sioux Falls is second with 40 mentions at No. 1 followed by Georgetown (Ky.) with 14, Northwestern Oklahoma State with 11 and St. Francis with three.

No hype necessary

No. 6 St. Xavier puts unbeaten season, big offensive numbers on line in return to the 'Fort' to tangle with 8th-ranked USF

As the University of Saint Francis focuses on the future, specifically NAIA sixth-ranked Saint Xavier University, the recent past still nags at the Cougars.

As if No. 8 USF needed any more incentive for Saturday's NAIA Top 10 clash, the USF Cougars are primed to prove that field conditions made the difference in their only loss this season just 12 days ago.

Additional motivating factors for both teams on Saturday include:

- NAIA Top 10 implications,
- Mid-States Football Association Mideast League title aspirations
- Post-season home field options for USF and SXU
- 56-consecutive wins at home for USF
- USF 'Senior Day'

This is also the first time since 1999 the Cougars are the 'under-dog' at home

based on NAIA Top 25 ratings.

On Oct. 2, 1999, USF was unranked when the Cougars upset No. 29 Geneva (PA) 56-26. USF is 3-13 in home and away games against higher ranked opposition. In the Cougars most recent clash with a higher ranked opponent, then No. 3 USF lost at then No. 2 Sioux Falls (S.D.) 24-6 last December.

a 30-27 win at No. 4 Bethel (TN) Nov. 24, 2007. USF was No. 5 in that NAIA Quarterfinal FCS game.

Comparisons are natural with the NAIA's No. 3 pass offense coming to Bishop D'Arcy Stadium to challenge the NAIA's 2nd-ranked pass defense. Undeclared SXU (10-0, 6-0 MSFA MEL) is determined to finish regular season play undefeated for the first time in its 17-season history and has carved out a perfect season to date on the arm of Anthony Kropp, who is averaging 315.2 yards passing per game and has thrown for an NAIA leading 35 touchdown passes.

At Missouri University Science & Technology on Oct. 24, Miners quarterback Jason Schlueter completed 35-of-47 passes for 438 yards and three TD passes to lead the NCAA II team to a 39-37 win. Schlueter set USF opponent highs for passing yards and completion percentage (.745) and the Miners 587 yards in total offense was the third highest in USF history and the first 500 or more yards in total offense yielded by USF in its last 110 games.

USF head coach Kevin Donley's message was that bottom line, the Cougars didn't find a way to get the W and that what matters most is what the coaches and team do to win the last three games (now two) -- all conference games.

"One of our goals was to go undefeated, but another just as important goal was to win the conference," senior ILB Carl Thomas said. "WE have control over that and that is what we are focused on and working toward. That (the MUS&T game) was not us."

Between the two teams they are ranked in the MSFA top five in 18 different statistical categories.

This will be the eighth time an unbeaten team pays a visit to USF, the first time since 2006 when 9-0 Walsh University visited for an MSFA MEL championship showdown.
