# Basketball Camp Directors

Jeff Rekeweg, three-time MCC Coach of the Year, and 2010 National Coach of the year just ended his fourteenth season at the helm of the Cougars. Rekeweg has taken a program that had seen some success to a perennial nationally rated team. The 2010 Cougars won the first ever National Championship for the University of Saint Francis. Coach Rekeweg has developed seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year in his fourteen years at Saint Francis.

Coach Rekeweg has recently taken the head coaching position at Northwood University in Midland, MI.

Chad LaCross, recently ended his seventh season with Cougars and second as Associate Head Coach. With the departure of Coach Rekeweg, LaCross has been promoted as the 6<sup>th</sup> Head Coach in the history of the University of Saint Francis.

LaCross graduated from East Noble High School in 1997 where he was named to the Indiana All-Star team. In 2001 he graduated from Tri-State University (Trine). LaCross still holds seven TSU records and is the all-time leading scorer. He left TSU as a three time All-American.
